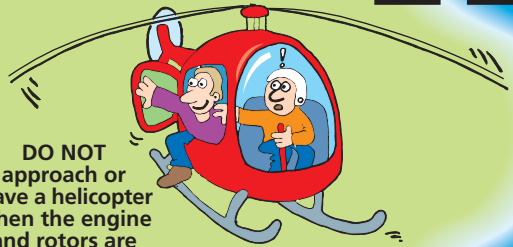


# THINK



DO NOT approach or leave a helicopter when the engine and rotors are running down or starting up.



If blinded by swirling dust or grit, STOP – crouch lower, or sit down and await assistance.

# HELICOPTER



NEVER approach or leave uphill. ALWAYS approach or leave from the downhill side



Carry long objects horizontally, NOT upright or over the shoulder.

# SAFETY



- Always keep eye contact with the pilot and only approach after receiving visual approval.
- Never, never walk around the back of a helicopter.
- Never throw any object in the vicinity of the helicopter.
- Fasten seatbelt on entering helicopter and leave it done up until pilot signals to get out.
- Keep well clear of landing areas when helicopter is landing or taking off.
- Hold onto your hat. Never reach up or chase after hat or other articles that blow away.
